At the September 7, 2021 Town Council meeting the Town Council voted to credit all water users with half of their base rate for the next three months, as part of this ARPA funding. You will see this credit on your bill for the months of October, November and December. We hope this helps a little with any of the problems that COVID and the financial issues related to COVID may have created for you and your families.

- Step 4: Complete the short registration form and click "Next"
- Step 5: Go to your inbox and open the verification email, click "Verify Email" and "Continue" to log in
- Step 6: Select your billing organization
- Step 7: Enter your account number and last name, then click in the box to opt in for paperless and select "Locate Bill" and select "Locate Account"
